Barpro Basics

Q: What can we do to keep our mobiles safe?

A: Personnel safety has always been an integral part of the Storax Mobile Design. The Storax System is designed to be safe according to SEMA Standards, but it still needs to be maintained in such a condition by the company operating the system. Here are a few tips for keeping your mobiles in a safe and standard work condition:

- * Check that all the trip bars on the system are operating correctly i.e. mobile stops when the trip bar is activated.
- * Check that all push button controls work correctly on each mobile.
- * Make sure that the photo barrier system (1 per bank), if installed, works correctly.
- * Any damage to side members or tripbars needs to be reported, and replaced immediately.
- * The racking superstructure should also be checked and any damage should also be reported immediately.

It is best to have an appointed person who checks the system on a continuous basis. A standard form should be completed stating the dates of the inspections and the findings. A permanent record reflecting maintenance of your mobiles would ensure that the same problems don't re-occur.
